Free COVID-19 Money Offers on WhatsApp and Facebook Are Scams

People have reported seeing messages that seem to be from Pepsi, Walmart, Whole Foods, Target, and other big-name brands. These messages all offer money to people who need it — through grants, coupons for food support, or other giveaways. But they're all fake, and not from those companies at all. You might get this kind of message, in English or Spanish, from a friend or contact. The message tells you to click a link to get your money. If you click, you might find a survey to take. Or they might ask you to enter your name, address, phone number, or other information. And they might ask you to forward the message to several friends to be eligible to collect. Don't click on any links. That could download malware, expose you to even more scams, or add your phone number to lists sold to still other scammers. Delete the messages – and certainly don't share them.

Call the friend who shared the message. Did they forward it to you? If not, tell them their account might have been hacked. SOURCE: Federal Trade Commission
