Overdue Toll Charges Scam

You receive a text telling you to click a link to pay "overdue toll charges" to avoid late fees. But it's probably not the tolling agency contacting you. It's probably a scammer. Clicking the link can lead to a phishing attack, where the scammer tries to take your personal information (like your driver's

license number) and even steal your identity. And if you pay, not only are you out the money, but the scammer gets your credit card number, too. Don't rush to click on links or respond to the text. Scammers want you to react quickly. Check with the tolling agency. If you're worried the text is legit, check with the state's tolling agency. But use a phone number or website you know is real — not the info from the text. Report unwanted text messages. Use your phone's "report junk" option to report these unwanted texts to your messaging app or forward them to 7726 (SPAM). Don't engage. Delete the message. Unwanted messages often lead to scams. Once you've checked it out and reported it, delete the text message. SOURCE: Federal Trade Commission
